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Ranulas are that can be seen in the floor of the mouth results from an injury to the duct of salivary glands, usually the major salivary glands. Ranulas present as a swelling of connective tissue consisting of collected mucin. Ranulas may be asymptomatic.

Treatment

- Incision and drainage
- Ranula excision
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- Complete excision of the ranula with the sublingual gland
